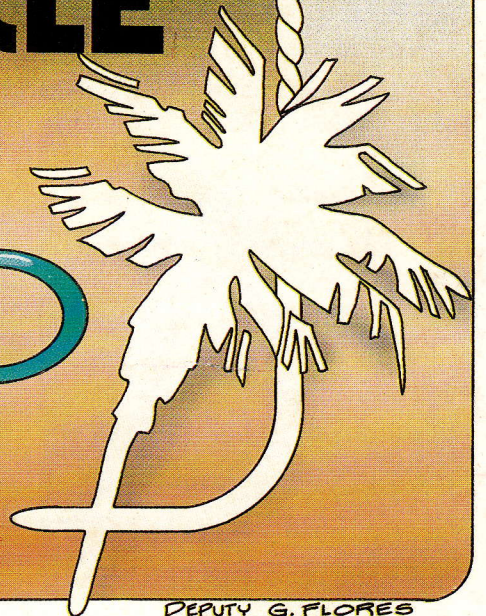

SOUTH EAST POLICE MOTORCYCLE RODEO COMMITTEE

WELCOME

A hearty welcome is extended to all participants and guests of the First Annual South East Police Motorcycle Rodeo. It is a spin-off of the Mid-Atlantic Police Motorcycle Rodeo held each year in the Washington D.C. area.

Like that event, the purpose of this rodeo is to provide an opportunity for motorcycle officers to meet their counterparts from other jurisdictions in a fun-filled day of friendly competition, and to promote comraderie while improving harmonious working relationships among police agencies.

The Rodeo is free to the public and open to all motorcycle officers wishing to compete from any department nationwide. Competition consists of cone courses designed to challenge a rider's skill in safe and precise motorcycle operation. To successfully compete in these courses, a rider must exercise good judgement, precise positioning, and utilize smooth clutch, throttle and brake coordination.

Judging is based on the number of errors a rider makes. All riders start with a score of zero and the rider with the lowest score wins. Ties will be broken by a two step run-off with the winner being determined by the judges, based on the amount of errors and final times in the run-off.

I would like to thank those who helped make this rodeo a reality. A special thanks goes out to Harley-Davidson of Fort Lauderdale for providing the committee a place to hold our many meetings in planning this event; to Harley-Davidson Motor Company, Inc. for donating the 883 Sportster being raffled at the rodeo; to Broward County Sheriff Nick Navarro for providing the talent of Elaine Miceli to assist the committee with fundraising and producing this program; to the Blue Knights M.C. for judging the rodeo; and to all the officers of the committee and their families who worked so unselfishly towards this end for the last six months.

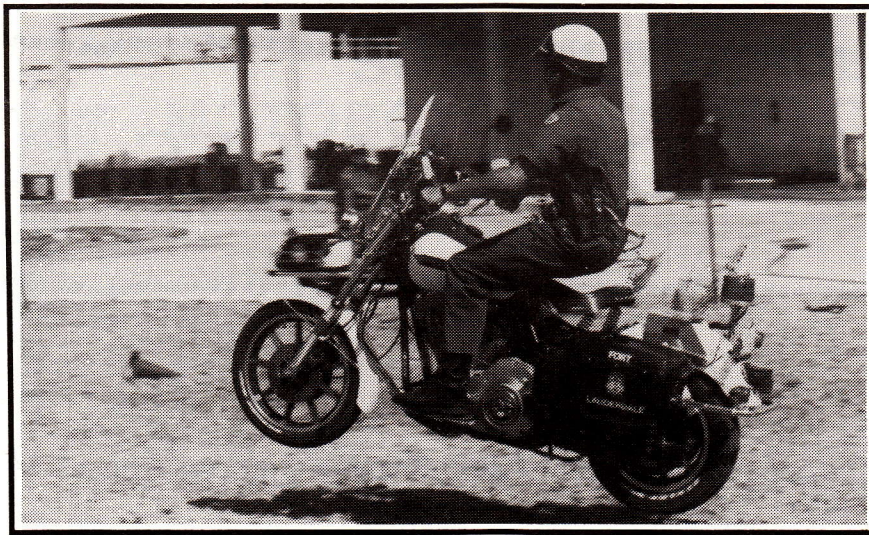
RODEO RULES

I. General Rules

- a. Competition shall be open to all full-time law enforcement officers who are assigned to a police motorcycle unit.
- b. Riders must compete on a police motorcycle of at least 1000 CC's that is equipped in the normal deployment configuration.
- c. Riders must compete wearing the appropriate uniform normally worn on duty.

II. Individual Competition

- a. 1st through 5th places will receive a trophy.
- b. The object of the competition is to not receive any penalty points. The rider will begin with a score of ZERO.
- c. Penalty points are assessed as follows:
 - 1 POINT - Touch a cone
 - 2 POINTS - Knock down a cone
 - 2 POINTS - Put a foot down
 - 5 POINTS - Drop the motorcycle
 - 5 POINTS - Fail to complete an event (includes not following the path of travel as required)
 - 5 POINTS - Running out of an event (when the front AND the rear wheels cross the imaginary line between the center points of the two adjacent cones where the motorcycle would not normally enter or exit an event)
- d. A maximum of five (5) penalty points is all one rider can be assessed in any one course. If penalty points exceed the five point maximum, the rider is then disqualified from that particular course and must go on to the next course.
- e. Riders will be required to make two untimed runs through the five events. The total score will be counted for the final placement in the competition.
- f. Course Dimension: Due to the different types of motorcycles deployed by the various departments, various course sizes will be established as needed.
- g. Ties: All ties for first through fifth place will be broken in the following manner. A tie is considered two or more riders with two perfect runs.
 1. PHASE I: A timed run will be made through all five events with the object being to complete the course AS FAST AS POSSIBLE with as few mistakes as possible. During the timed event, penalty points will be assessed as described in section II: C.
 2. PHASE II: A timed run will be made through the 'NO-NAME' course with the object being to complete the event AS SLOW AS POSSIBLE with as few mistakes as possible. During Phase II, penalty points will be assessed as follows:
 - 1 POINT - Touch a cone
 - 2 POINTS - Knock down a cone
 - 5 POINTS + STOPPING RIDERS TIME - Rider puts foot down, drops the motorcycle, fails to complete the course or runs out of the event.



III. Team Competition

- a. 1st through 5th places will receive trophies.
- b. A team will consist of the four best scores taken from the untimed individual competition for each department.
- c. All four scores are added together and the lowest total score will be awarded FIRST PLACE. The next lowest total score will be awarded SECOND PLACE, etc.
- d. Ties: All ties will be broken by adding the tying team's fifth place finisher to the total scores. If there is still a tie, the sixth place finisher's score will be added, etc., until the tie is broken. In the event a small agency runs out of competitors in the tie-breaker process (i.e., no 5th place rider), the larger agency with the most riders will be declared the winner.

IV. Slow Ride Team Competition

- a. 1st through 5th places will receive trophies.
- b. The object of the competition is for four riders to travel down a 50-foot-long, 8-foot-wide path as slow as possible without leaving the course, putting a foot down, or dropping the motor. The slowest combined times of all four riders from any one team will determine the winner. The next slowest combined times will be considered second, etc.
- c. Riders #1 and #3 begin at one end of the lane with riders #2 and #4 beginning at the other end of the same lane.
- d. At the judges command, rider #1 raises his/her foot and begins down the lane as slow as possible.
- e. When rider #1's front axle is about to exit the lane, rider #2 must raise his/her foot, enter the lane, and proceed to the other end with his/her front axle entering the lane before rider #1's front axle crosses the exit line.
- f. Riders #3 and #4 proceed as listed in "d" and "e" above.
- g. The judge will stop AND record the time for the TEAM when:
 - (1) Rider #4's REAR axle crosses the exit line.
 - (2) ANY rider puts a foot down.
 - (3) ANY rider touches the side lines.
 - (4) ANY rider fails to enter the lane on time.
 - (5) ANY rider drops the motorcycle.
- h. Agencies may enter as many teams as they wish. However, an individual may only ride on one team.
- i. A rider may compete in this event without having competed in the other events. all other rules, however, still apply.

V. Division Competition

- a. 1st through 3rd places in each of the six divisions will receive trophies.
- b. Ties: All riders in each division who are tied after completion of the two untimed runs and have no penalty points will enter the tie-breaker as described in section II, G; 1 & 2 of these official rules.
- c. Should only one rider in a division complete two perfect runs that rider will be considered the winner and the rider with the next lowest number of penalty points winning second, etc.
- d. Should no riders in a division complete two perfect runs that rider will be considered the winner and the rider with the next lowest number of penalty points winning second, etc.
- e. If more than one rider has the same number of penalty points and is tied for 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place of that division, then the Phase I tie-breaker will be run as described in section II, G; 1 of these official rules. If a tie still exists for one of the three places, then the Phase II tie-breaker as described in section III, G; 2 of these official rules will be run.
- f. The six divisions will be as follows:
 - Division I - Kawasakis with fairings AND altered fork-stops; Kawasakis with windshields.
 - Division II - Harley-Davidson FLHTP.
 - Division III - Kawasakis with fairings AND unaltered fork-stops
 - Division IV - Harley-Davidson FLH.
 - Division V - Harley-Davidson FXRP with windshields only.
 - Division VI - Harley-Davidson FXRP with fairings.



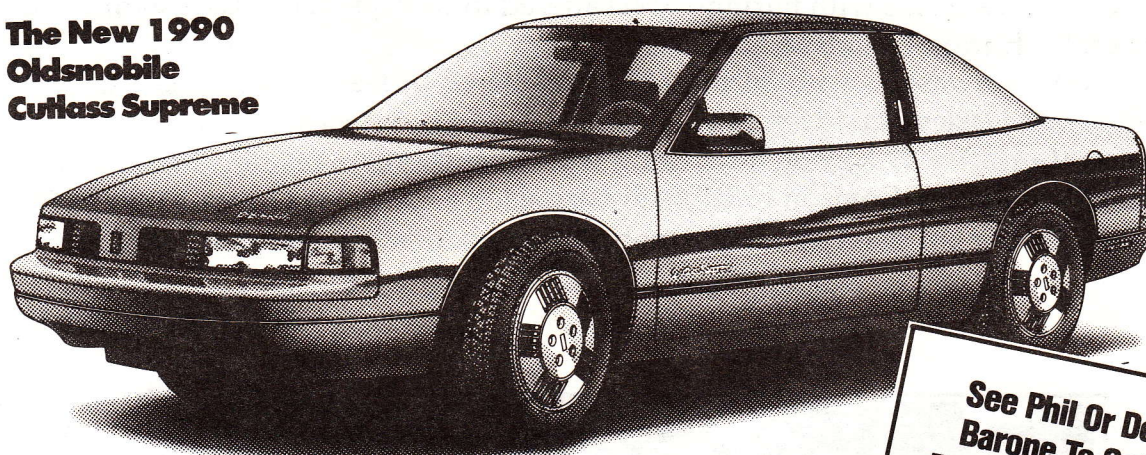

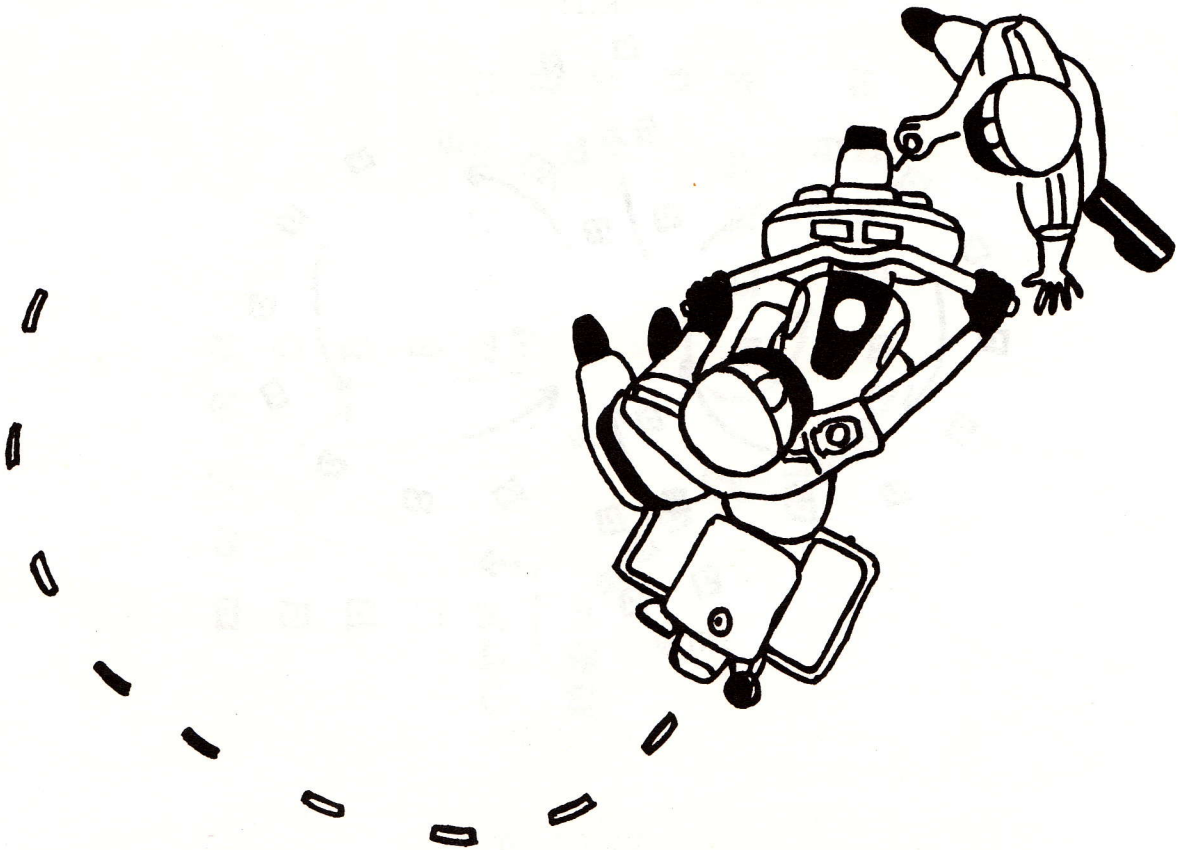

COURSE DESCRIPTION

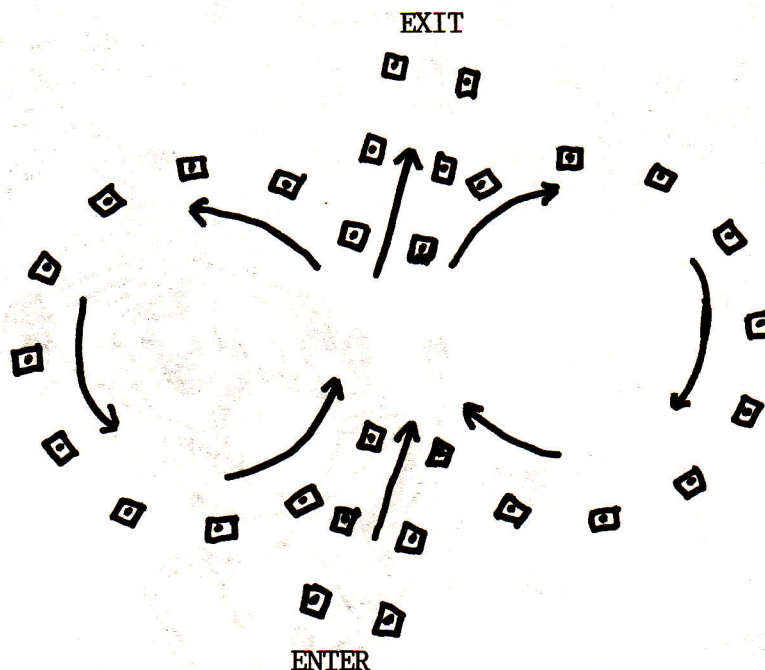


COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Rodeo is comprised of five separate cone courses designed to test a rider's skill. The courses test a rider's ability to make sharp tight turns, tight circles to the right and left, weaving through cones using proper speed and body lean, and maintaining ballance and overall control in limited areas. Precise use and coordination of the clutch, throttle, and brakes are necessary to successfully complete the course.

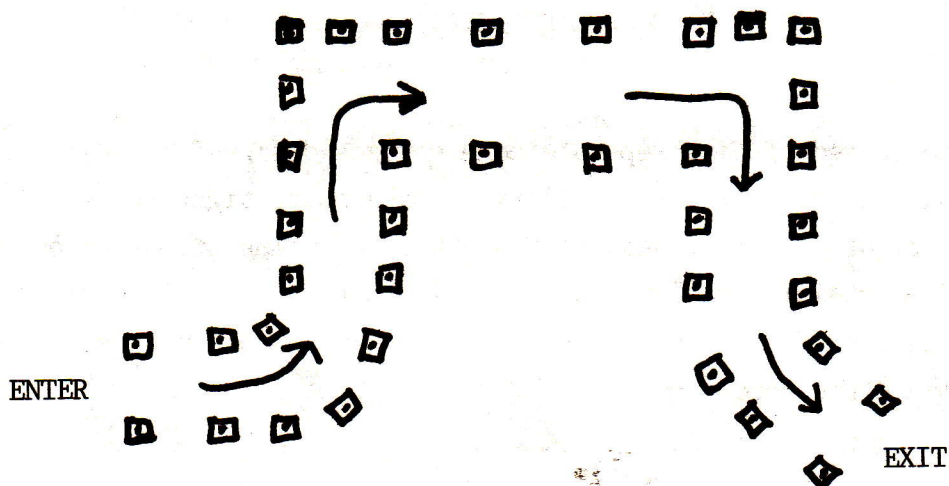
THE FIGURE EIGHT

The rider enters the first circle making a slow right hand turn in a limited area, then continues into the second circle making a slow left turn, then exits.



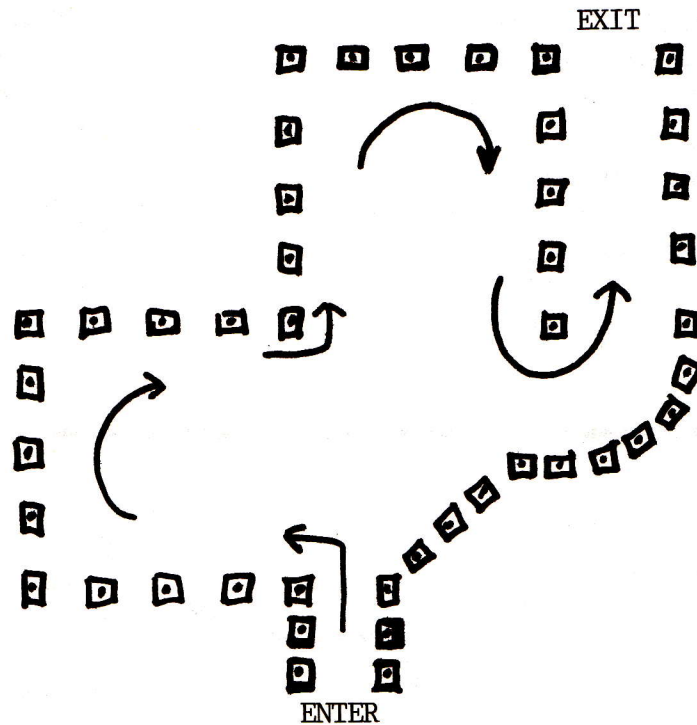
OFFSET ALLEY

The rider enters the obstacle making a tight sharp left turn, then makes two 90 degree right turns and exits the course with a tight left turn.



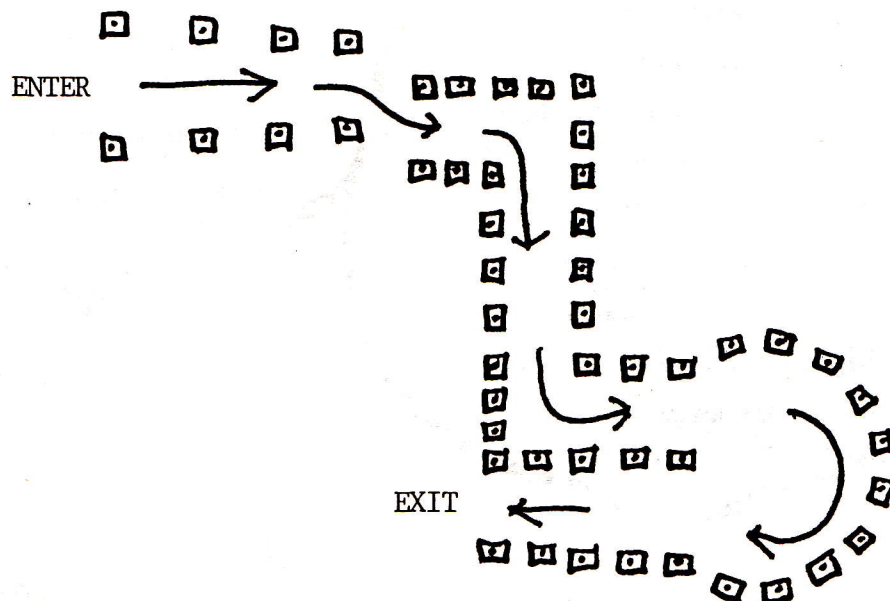
INTERSECTION

The rider enters the intersection making a slow 90 degree turn to the left, then a u-turn to the right in a limited area, another 90 degree turn to the left, one more u-turn to the right, and exits the course with a locked wheel u-turn to the left.



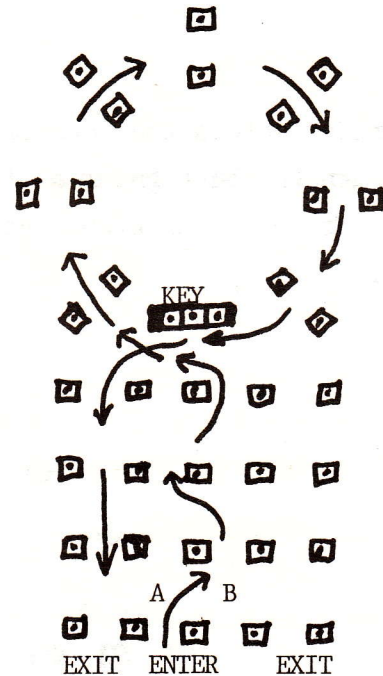
THE NO NAME

The rider enters a long narrow chute, then has to ride through an offset lane and make a sharp 90 degree right turn, followed by a 90 degree left turn into a tight circle to the right and out the exit. This course is also used for phase two of the tie breaker.



THE NATIONAL COMPETITION COURSE

The rider enters the course and weaves around the center row of cones making a sharp turn into the circle at the top of the course. The rider follows the circle passing beneath the key cones making a sharp slow turn into the outside exit lane. Starting in lane (B) will bring the rider out through the right hand exit as opposed to the left as illustrated.

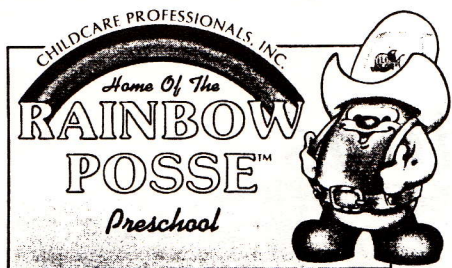
